## **CODE OF CONDUCT/RULES**

- # Black Trousers/Skirts to be worn AT ALL TIMES on match days.
- # County Match Shirts **MUST** be worn whilst playing games  
(Only County Polo Shirts may be worn whilst not on stage **IF** you prefer).
- # There is to be no 'back stabbing' via facebook, internet, e-mail, text or any other ways of communication, if you have a problem or disagree with a decision, speak to the management.
- # Full attendance is expected for **ALL** games (playing or not) and get together. If you are unavailable for certain dates, you must ensure the management are notified in plenty of time with a valid reason.
- # No persons under 18 years of age are to drink alcohol and players from the Under 21's must limit their alcohol to an acceptable level.
- # No Alcohol is to be consumed 'on stage'
- # No Players are to turn up 'Hungover'
- # Seats in the mini-buses **MUST** be confirmed at the league game prior to the event. Once booked you are responsible for that seat and therefore agree to pay for it! There will be no last minute 'changes' for seats already booked. (Players and their families will have first choice and if seats are left available they will be offered to supporters). We have two mini bus's available this year if required.
- # Entry Fees will apply to all home & away games and therefore **MUST** be paid by all players, management, officials & supporters.
- # It is **NOT** a god given right to play for the County, it is ability & attitude
- # Please help on the 'Top Table', more players are needed to work on the computer, music etc.
- # **RESPECT**, it works both ways! Treat people the way you expect to be treated.
