

Summer Superleague 2013

Littlehampton won this season's County Super League Championship in an exciting playoff at the Roffey Social Club, defeating the East Division winners Lewes by 6-3.

The Littlehampton team had previously won their Division by just four points from last year's champions Worthing.

The Lewes side had only lost three of their sixteen matches this year and they beat off a strong challenge from previous winners Newhaven to take the East Division title by fifteen points.

Rod Hawkins started the ball rolling for Lewes with a 3-0 win over Ross Gillingham which included the top checkout of the evening, 135. Lee Franklyn came back strongly for Littlehampton defeating Dennis Sains by 3-1. The Coco Lounge Club's success continued with James Stephenson beating Micky Whiting 3-1, followed by Mick Rodgers who registered the night's best average with a 27.77, winning by 3-1 against Ricki Blay, including a 12 dart leg. This put Littlehampton 3-1 up but Lewes fought back to take the next two games, with wins for Paul Telford, defeating Terry Howse by 3-1 and for Daniel Sains winning 3-0 against Craig Stoner. Sadly for Lewes there were no further wins for the TallyHo side, with Littlehampton taking all three remaining games by 3-0. Cliff Prior defeated Reg Harding Jr., Tony Ayres clinched the title beating Gavin Redshaw and Gary Blackwood defeated Dave Harding to keep the County Super League in West Sussex.
